## **Recognizing Opportunities to Serve in the Church**

As you attend church, ask the Lord to reveal to you the opportunities and possibilities for serving.

#### Be OPEN!

#### O = Observe

Observe the following:

The areas God is working Who is overworked Who needs help

## P = Pray

Pray with purpose:

For a burden to serve

For awareness of opportunities to serve

For sensitivity to the Spirit's leading toward a particular service

## E = Engage

Engage with other servants:

Ask leaders in the church to share their vision with you

Ask leaders where they need people to serve

Ask leaders to pray for you as you seek a place of service

#### N = Now

Now is the time to get started!

You learn to serve by serving

Commit to moving forward in God's plan as your eyes are OPENed!

- O: Observe
- P: Prayer
- E: Engage
- N: Now

#### SERVICE INVENTORY

Consider the following as you evaluate all that God has given you to equip and prepare you for service in your church.

## 1. Spiritual growth

Opportunities God has provided for you to mature in Christ.

## 2. Talents God has given you

(e.g., art, music, athletic ability, prayer, driving skills, good rapport with children, communication skills, audio-visual, computer skill, decorating, cooking, mechanical ability, etc.)

## 3. Spiritual gifts God has given you

If you are not sure, ask a leader in your church for help in discovering your gifts.

## 4. Resources with which God has blessed you

(e.g., income, home, car, clothes, food, bicycle, computer, furniture, a garden, books, etc.)

## 5. Family

(e.g., ways your family could serve together)

#### 6. Job/Career

(e.g., skills that you have gained from job/career)

## 7. Life stage

Opportunities associated with your present stage of life (single, married, children, retired)

#### 8. Time

Availability in your current schedule or adjustments you could make

#### 9. Hobbies/Other interests

The extra skills you have acquired in life

#### 10. Mentoring

People who could benefit from your investment into their life

#### 11. Creative planning

Events or outreaches you could host/organize for your church (one time or ongoing)

## 12. Give thanks, and get started!

Thank Him for what He has provided and for the privilege of serving Him in your church!
